## Club Rules/Etiquette

- If you fall, get up as quickly as you can.
- No headphones, no backward spirals without a spotter.
- Practice jumps in the corners and spins in the center of the rink.
- ORANGE VESTS always have the right of way.
- Let beginners use the wall.
- Keep your head up and move out of the way of a skater skating backwards.
- Do not stand in the middle of the rink.
- Look both ways before getting on the ice.
- BE COURTEOUS and RESPECTFUL.

## 3 Basic Steps in Skate Care:

1. Wipe boots down inside and out because moisture and bacteria from your feet can attack leather and cause mold, mildew, and rotting.
2. Loosen laces and pull the tongue forward to let your boots dry. It's tempting to store your boots in a locker or skate bag immediately after practice, but it is always best to let your skates dry at room temperature.
3. Did you know a typical leather boot can soak up to a pound of excess moisture? We recommend using silicone protectant to prevent moisture buildup in the leather. Talk to your dealer about this and other boot care products.
